

Poster Instructions

The Poster Session will be held on Tuesday, September 8, 4:30-6:30pm in the Main hall at the Uppsala Castle. You will have time to put up your posters on an allocated space recognized by the title of the paper on Monday, 3:00-5:00pm, and on Tuesday, 8:00-00:00am.

Each presenter is expected to be present with her/his poster during the Poster Presentation Session to explain her/his presentation and answer attendees' questions. If you would like to keep your poster, you must take it with you at the end of the Poster Session.

Please follow these instructions for preparing your posters.

1. Poster presenters should bring all printed materials for their posters with them to the conference. Pins and tapes for posters to be taped on the board will be provided at the site.
2. The poster must be written in English and must fit within a 1.3 m (height) x 0.9 m (width) space.
3. Put the title, authors' name, affiliation (72 point) and contact information (60 point) on the poster.
4. The poster should be easily readable at a distance of about 2 m. The recommended font sizes are 96 point bold font for title and at least 36 point for text.
5. Plan the outline of your poster! Do not put too much information into the presentation, instead, try to focus on two or three main points. Make all diagrams, tables and pictures clear and simple to understand.
